

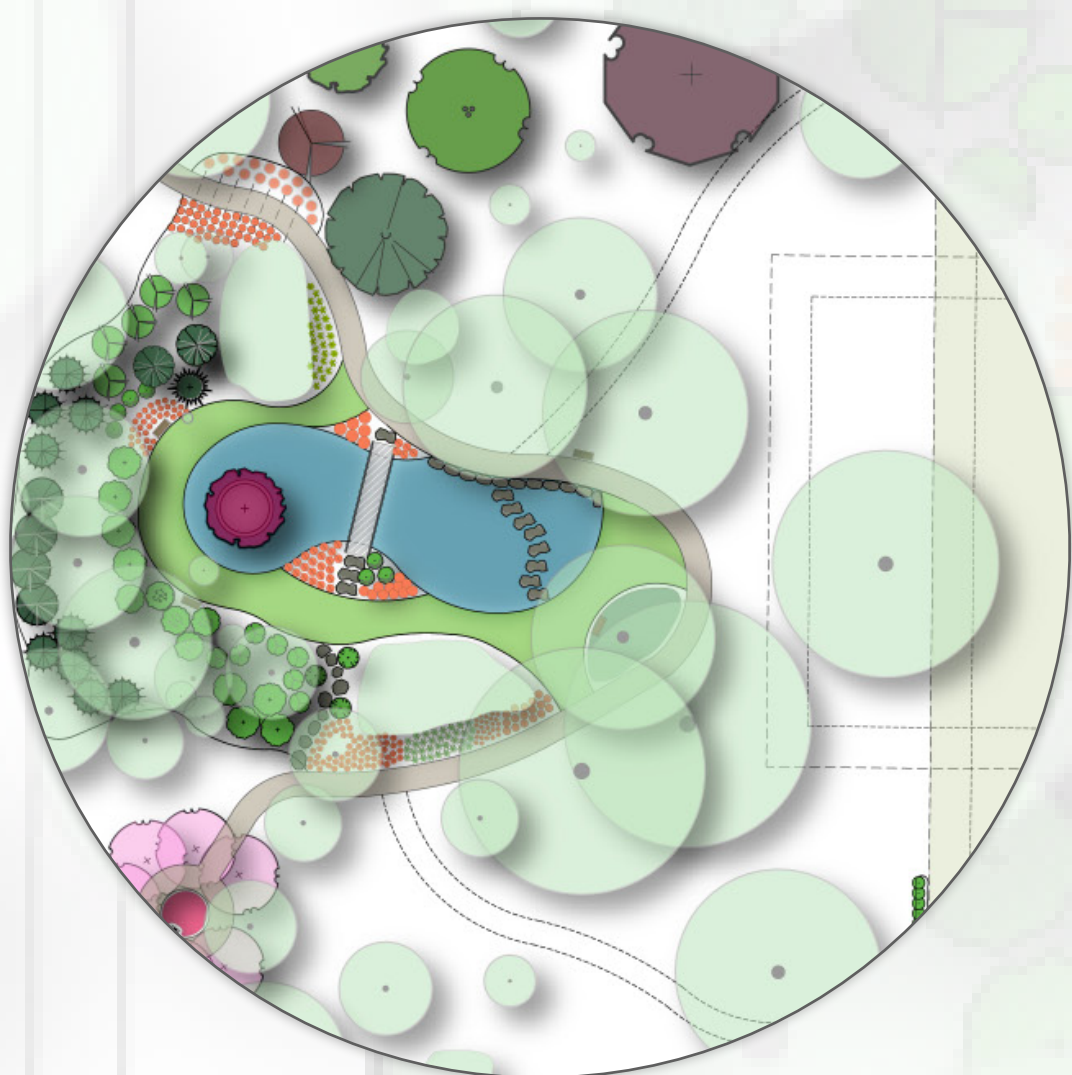

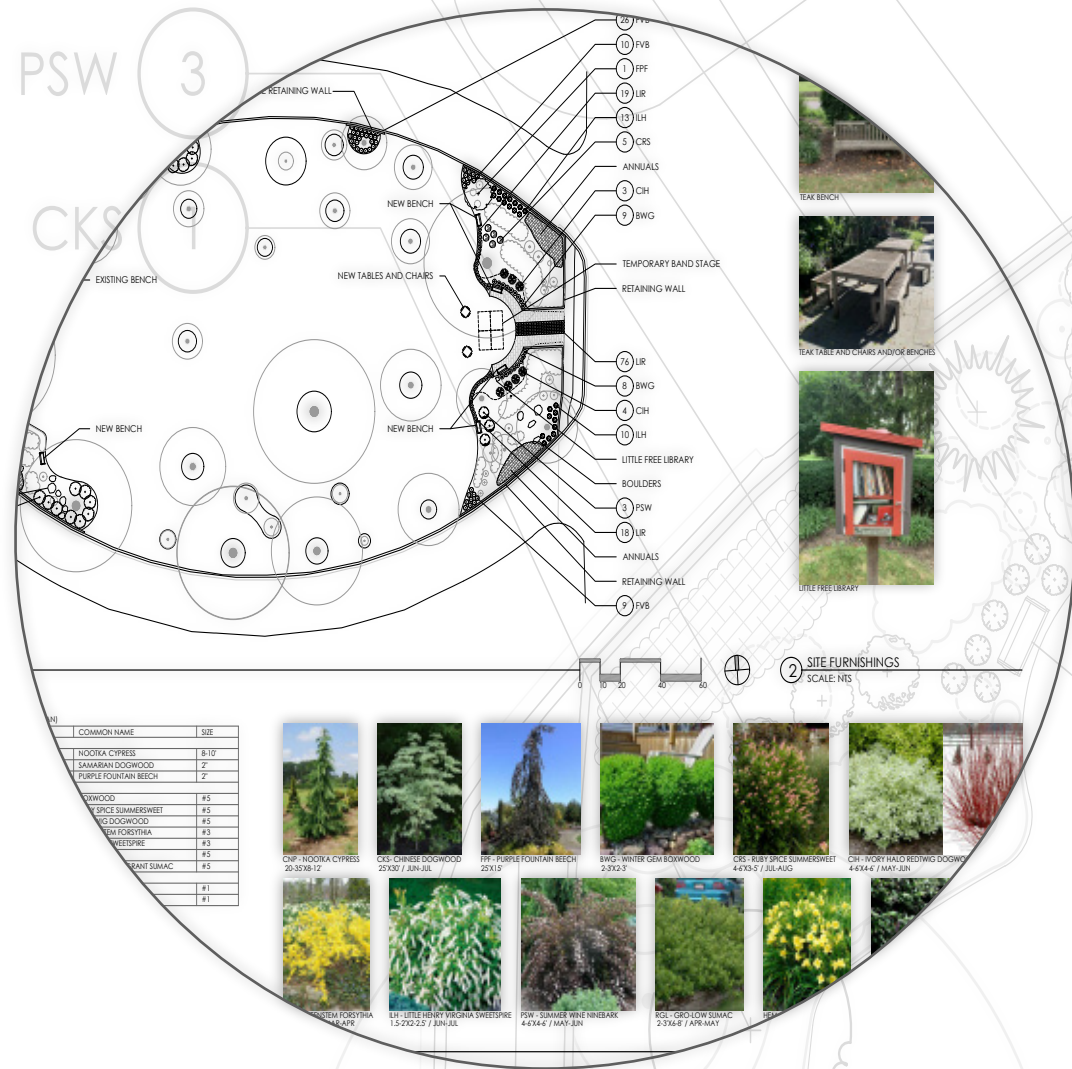

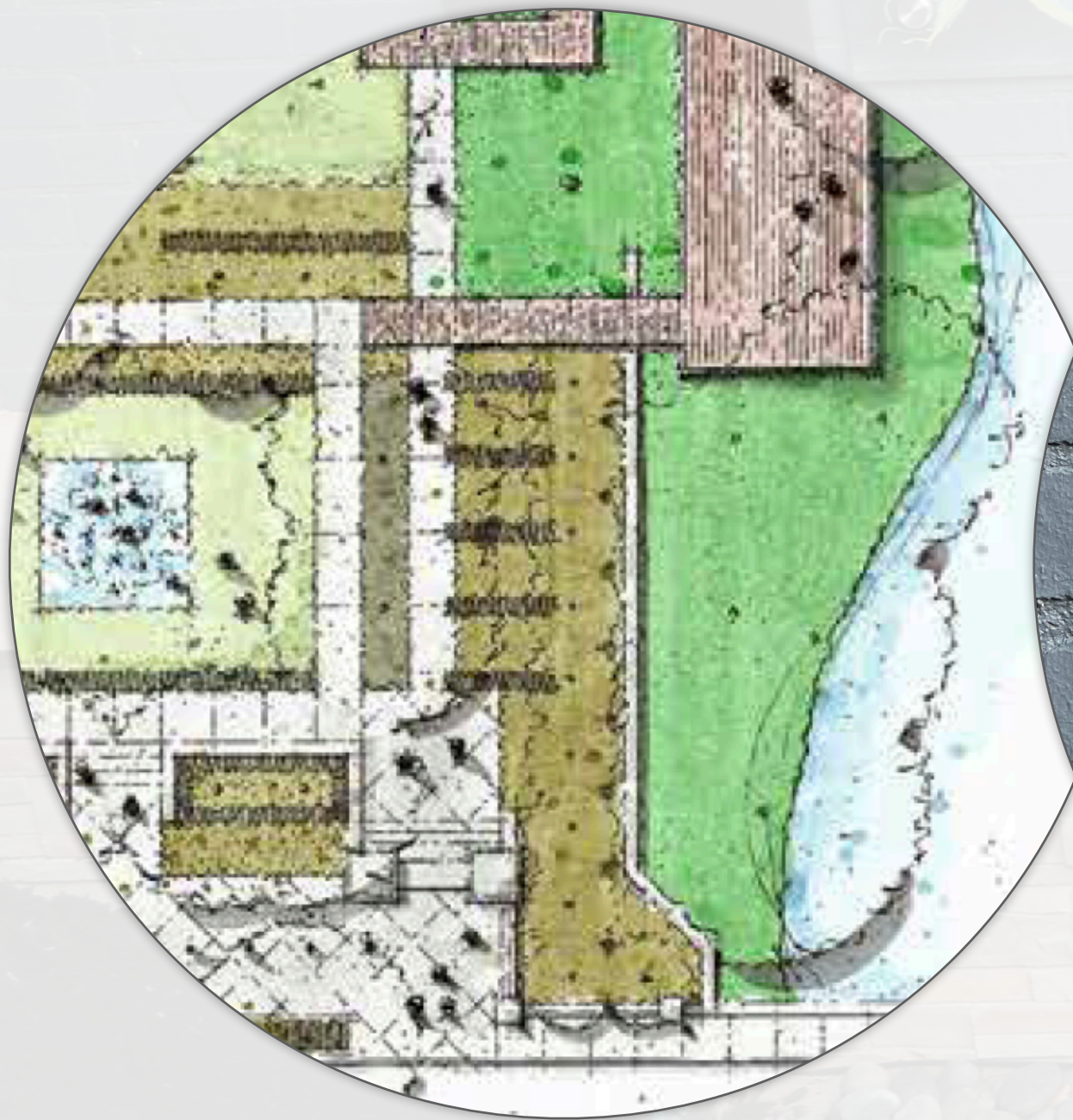
# BEXLEY NATURAL DOG PARK

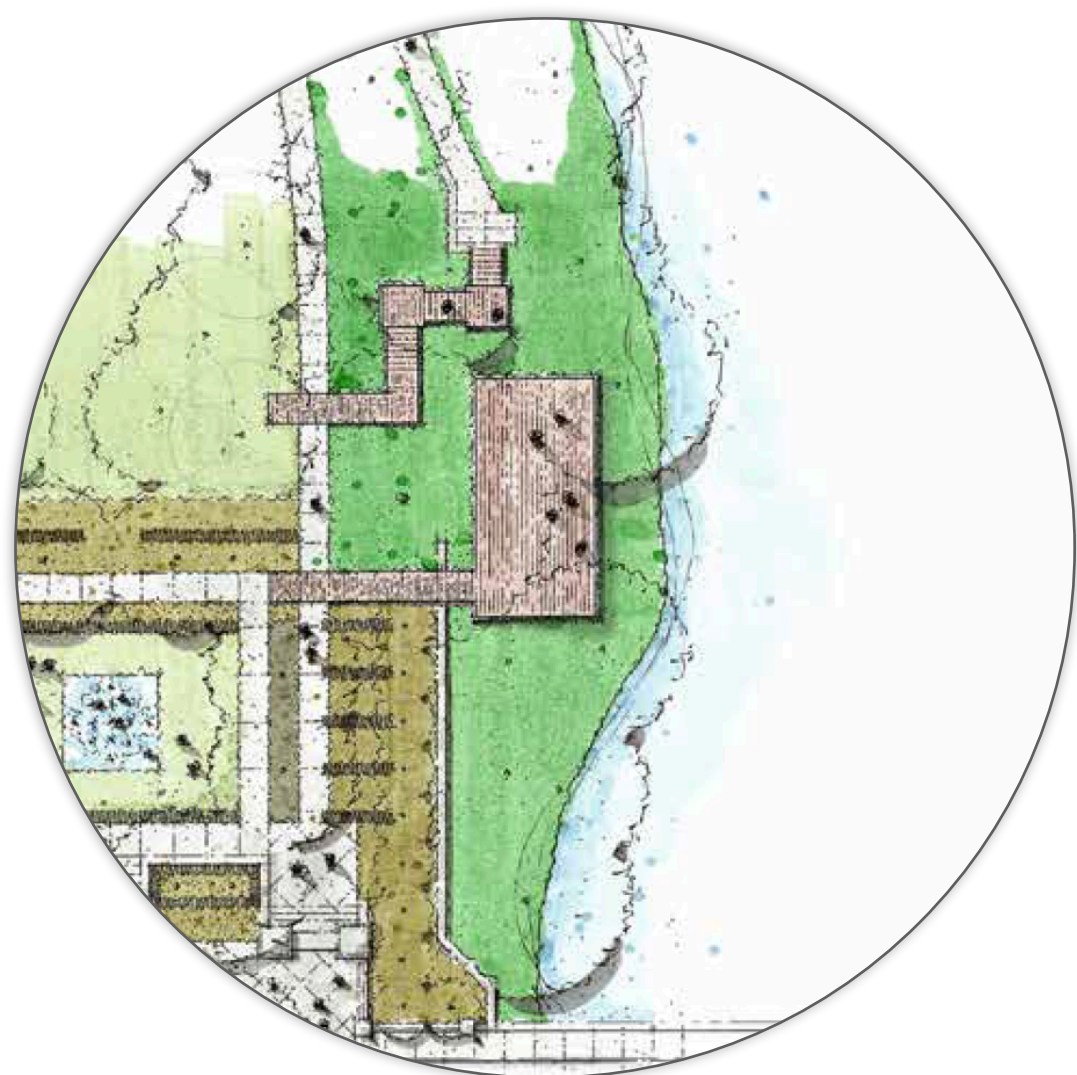
