

Legislative Updates:

The Ohio statehouse was very active during the December lame duck session. Here are some items impacting local governments:

Flavored Tobacco Ban Update

Local pre-emption, vetoed by Governor DeWine

Distracted Driving Legislation

Primary offense - difficult to enforce. Allows hands-on calling, and texting while stopped at traffic lights, etc.

Pesticide Pre-emption

Restricts the right of local governments to regulate pesticides. This may be of interest to us with mosquito program discussions.

Designed for newly elected officials (or experienced officials seeking a refresher), this introductory series promotes a high-level of understanding of topics essential to services as a local council, board, or commission member.
