

Recreation Board Meeting:

- The Recreation Board met on Wed., June 7th at 530.
 - The board received a report on the Jeffrey Park Preservation ad Enhancement Committee kick-off meeting which was held on Tue., May 23rd.
 - The board was updated on the following items:

 - Pool Opening

Jeffrey Park Preservation and Enhancement Plan Committee:

- The Jeffrey Park Preservation and Enhancement Plan Committee (JPPEPC) held a kick-off meeting on Tue., May 23rd.
- The committee discussed the goals of the plan and the role of the committee.
- The committee reviewed the OHM Advisors contract for committee facilitation services.
- We are in the process of scheduling a small group meeting with OHM Advisors as we work to put a committee schedule together and begin moving the process forward.
- The committee will work over the next 6-9 months to put together a preservation and enhancement plan for Jeffrey Park with the goal of ensuring that the park thrives and is enjoyed by residents and visitors for generations to come.

David H. Madison Community Pool Opening Update:

- The community pool opened on Saturday, May 27th. It was a very nice weekend for the pool opening with very warm weather on Memorial Day.
- Memorial weekend saw just under 1882 visitors to the pool
- Current Pool Memberships
 - Residents – 3108 (2885 in 2022)
 - Resident Sponsored – 255 (207 in 2022)
 - Total – 3363 (3092 in 2022)
- Staffing levels continue to be very strong. Additionally, the facility looked terrific thanks to improvements to the slides, bathrooms, new pool chairs and new upper deck picnic tables.



Jeffrey Summer Camp Opening Week:

- Jeffrey Summer Camp opened last week for the first of ten weeks this summer.
- Registration numbers are up from last year with the following registrations for 2023:
 - Total individual registrants – 522 (433 in 2022)
 - Total registration weeks – 2988 (2772 in 2022)
 - Average attendance – 299 per week (277 per week in 2022)
- Week one had an unusual air quality alert which we worked through.
 - Steps included reduced intensity of activities
 - Kept a close eye on campers/staff with risk factors like asthma and allergies
 - Spent some additional time inside as needed
- Camp Adventure, with 59 middle school campers, traveled to Kings Island. The weather could not have been better and a good time was had by all (I think)
 - The next Camp Adventure trip is this Wed., June 14th to Splatter Park for some paintball.
- Overall, camp is off to a great start. The cooler weather has been much appreciated by the staff. Staffing levels have been great, and we are very excited about the team of staff we have been able to put together this year.
