### Jeffrey Mansion Application in for State Capital Budget

The City has applied for funds from the 2017/2018 State Capital Budget for the Jeffrey Mansion project. We are

asking for \$1,200,000 to assist with the funding of the project. A copy of the application has been circulated. The next step is for us to have discussions with local legislators and influencers to try to get the project recommended through Columbus 2020, and to place it on the radar of state legislators.

### CoGo Bike Share Locations

Bill Dorman and I have worked with Columbus to provide our final recommendations for CoGo BikeShare locations. They are:

- In front of City Hall
- At Capital University – in front of the athletic center (catty corner to Car2Go parking area)
- In front of Wesbanco (next to Johnson's Ice Cream)
- At Jeffrey Park, Clifton Avenue (near pool and tennis courts)
