Resolution #18. Presented by H. T. Fishpaw.

Declaring it necessary to improve College Avenue, formerly known as "the Winchester Pike" from Main Street to Livingston Avenue by constructing on the east side of said Avenue a cinder foot path or sidewalk.

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley State of Ohio, three fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:-

Section 1 That it is necessary to improve College Avenue, from Main Street in said village to Livingston Avenue, the south boundary of said village by constructing on the East side of said Avenue a cinder sidewalk or foot path as hereinafter described upon the grade heretofore established by the engineer and evinced by his stakes as now set as far as Clark Park Avenue and as much farther as practicable.

Section 2 That said sidewalk or foot path shall be made of coal cinders laid in an excavation 48 inches wide and 8 in deep, the eastern and inner line of said cinder sidewalk to be 36 in from the adjacent lot lines of abutting property; and said sidewalk to be constructed, and the total cost and expense of the same be paid by the lot and land owners whose lots and lands abutt the east side of said Avenue between the points above named, except as herein provided.

Section 3 That said sidewalk may be constructed by the owners of the several lots and parcels of land, bounding and abutting thereon at their own cost and expense, less one fifth of the total cost and expense of the same, and the cost and expense of the same across intersecting streets, public roads, alleys and highways in the Village, which said Village assumes and agrees to pay as its share of the cost and expense of said improvement; providing the owners of the said bounding and abutting lots and parcels of land shall construct said sidewalk in front of their respective lots and lands on or before December 1 - 1911.

Section 4 That if any part or portion of said sidewalk,

Resolution presented by Louis Lind #17

Resolved it is necessary to improve Park View Ave from Broad Street to the north corporation line of the village of Bexley Ohio; by constructing sidewalks of broken Stone on both sides thereof where the same is not already done.

Whereas certain lot owners on both sides of Park View Avenue between Broad Street and the north corporation line in the village of Bexley Ohio have constructed sidewalks of broken lime stone in front of their respective lots or parcels of land abutting upon said Park View Ave leaving the remaining lots and parcels of lands abutting upon said avenue without sidewalks of any kind, and

Whereas the winter season is now approaching when sidewalks are needed more than at any other season of the year, therefore, in order to make said sidewalks continuous on both sides of said Park View Avenue from Broad Street to the north corporation line of said Village, and provide suitable ways for pedestrians and the lot owners residing on said Park View Avenue to reach their homes.

Council meet in adjourned session. Meeting called to order by Mayor Holtzman. Member present Messrs Leonard Petzinger Lind Connor and Kneeland. Mr was present before the meeting and asked to be excused on account of sickness.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Mr Lind reported that he and Mr Kneeland had called on the Citizen Telephone Company in regard to the village using its poles for the light system and they had agreed to go over the ground the next day and report, but as the weather was so bad they could not do anything but thought there was no question but that arrangement could be made to use the poles. Motion carried that the clerk be instructed to advertise for bids as soon as the Committee obtained permission to use the poles of the three companies interested.

Report of Street Committee.

Mr Leonard reported that the committee had purchased 6 cars of stone that had been refused by the City of Columbus on account of being too large, but as it was the right size for new work they had bought and were putting the greater portion on Pleasant Ridge Ave and would put some on other street where they could be used. purchasing price \$6000.00. Com. had viewed the street in front of Mr Hutchinsons property and thought that a few loads of stone should be put on the worst places, and that some relief could be had from the surface water by cutting a furrow on each side of the street to drain the water to a large tile on the street. That there had been no action taken on the drain on Pleasant Ridge Ave as there was a question now on which direction the water could be carried the cheapest. Several of the property owners owning lots west of Pleasant Ridge Ave were anxious for the drain to be taken west to Alum creek having offered to give the right to cross their lots and pay for the privilege of tapping in the drain providing it is put of sufficient depth to allow

Resolution # 20

Bexley Ohio Nov 21-1911

Resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio: (Three fourth of all members elected thereto concurring)-
Section 1 That it is necessary to improve Park View Ave from the north side of Broad Street to the North side of Boston Ave by constructing on both sides of said Park View Avenue sidewalk on the grade as now established of cinders and broken stone four feet wide and eight inches in thickness to be laid in an excavation 8 inches in depth as follows to-wit:-

1st Five inches of cinders in the bottom to be leveled and tamped.

2nd Two inches of broken stone or clean gravel thereon to be leveled and tamped and

3rd One inch of fine broken or crushed stone upon the top on surface, and to be when so completed about on a level with, and not to exceed one inch above the unpaved portion of said sidewalk spaces.
