Ordinance. No. 27

- To proceed with College Avenue Sidewalk -

Whereas heretofore, on the 24 day of October 1911, on the Petition of the lot and land owners on the East side of College Avenue in the village of Basely Franklin County Ohio, the Council of said village adopted a Resolution declaring it necessary to improve the East side of said College Avenue from Main Street to Livingston Avenue by constructing thereon a Center Sidewalk, at the expense of the abutting lot & land owners, said lot and land owners under said Resolution having the privilege of constructing said Sidewalk on or before December 1. 1911 and

Whereas many of said abutting lot and land owners have already constructed said Sidewalk in front of their premises, but some of them have not done so, and said Sidewalk, as a whole is still incomplete, now therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the village of Basely, State of Ohio

Section I That it is hereby determined to proceed with the construction of said Sidewalk and complete the same as in said Resolution provided, and in accordance with the terms and requirements thereof

Section 2. That said Sidewalk shall be constructed on the level and grade shown on the Engineers Station, and the inner line of which to be 3 feet from the lot and property line, to be 4 feet wide and laid in an excavation 8 inches deep, and to be 8 inches in thickness when completed, and the surface of the same to be not more than one inch above the turf level when done.

Section 3 That the cost and expense of said uncompleted Sidewalk shall be upon the lot and land owners abutting thereon in proportion to their frontage, and shall be paid by said respective lot & landowners in one installment 30 days after the completion of said Sidewalk to the Treasurer of said village with interest thereon at

the rate of Six per Cent per annum; provided however if any lot or landowner (whose lot or land abuts upon said sidewalk) shall at or before the Contract is let to complete the same, complete the construction of said sidewalk in accordance with the plans, specifications and requirements herein and in said Resolution contained, at his own expense, said lot or land owner shall not be held liable for the cost and expense of constructing said sidewalk, or any part thereof in front of any other property on said College Avenue.

Section 4 That in order to avoid the cost and expense of advertising for bids, and also the delay in the completion of said sidewalk, said Village Council reserves the right to let the Contract or Contracts for the completion of said sidewalk without the formality of public bids, or under the supervision of the Village Street Commissioner, and the direction of the Council, complete said sidewalk at its option, at the cost and expense of the lot and land owners in front of whom premises said sidewalk shall not have been completed when this ordinance takes effect.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in operation from & after the earliest date allowed by law.
