

Ordinance No. 39.

(Determining to proceed with the improvement of Pleasant Ridge Avenue by the construction of sidewalks on either side thereof, as provided by Resolution passed March 26th, 1912.)

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Rexley, State of Ohio, three fourths of all members elected thereto concurring.

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the improvement of the sidewalks on Pleasant Ridge Avenue, as provided in the Resolution adopted by this Council March 26th, 1912, (or the incomplete portions thereof) from Main Street on the East Side, to 100 feet South of the Center of Carlisle Avenue, and on the West Side of said Avenue from Mound Street to 433 feet South of the Center of Carlisle Avenue to a point where a lane is designated, and in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles on file in the possession of the Village Clerk.

Section 2. That said owners of abutting lots and lands on both sides of said Pleasant Ridge Avenue, who have failed or refused to make said sidewalks as provided in said Resolution, within the time therein specified, shall pay for the cost and expense of completing said sidewalks, less 1/50 part thereof and the costs of intersections by assessments upon their respective lots and parcels of land in proportion to their frontage thereon, said assessments shall be made equally upon the front feet of the lots and lands so abutting upon the said sidewalks so completed hereunder.

Section 3. That said incomplete sidewalks shall be let to the lowest and best bidder as provided by law, and the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for the construction of said incomplete sidewalks in accordance with law.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
