

Resolution # 76

Resolution directing to advertise for bids for the construction of the proposed Sewer System within the Village of Bexley.

Whereas the legal voters of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio by a two thirds vote directed the Council of the Village of Bexley to put down and construct for the said Village of Bexley a complete sewer system and disposal plant and water system, and whereas, the engineer for said Village has complete plans and specifications for the construction of said Sewer therefore Be it resolved, that a legal notice for bids be published in two news papers of general circulation as provided by law; that said publication shall call for bids for the construction of the sewer system complete including the furnishing of all the material necessary for the construction of said Sewer as provided in the plans and specifications prepared by the engineer of said Village of Bexley, and on file in the office of the Village Clerk, and that said call for bids be so formulated, that the number of feet of sewer lines to be constructed can be increased or diminished at any time at will of the Council of the Village of Bexley; That the legal notice shall also be published in the following magazines:- Engineering Record 239 West 39th St., New York, Engineering and Contracting, 488 S. Dearborn Street, Chicago, and the American Contractor also of Chicago; Two insertions in each That the legal notice to be published shall be as follows:-
