

RESOLUTION No. 118

TO IMPROVE DREXEL AVENUE FROM MAIN STREET TO DALE AVENUE.

RESOLVED, By the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

(a) That it is necessary to improve Drexel Avenue from Main Street to Dale Avenue, by grading, draining, curbing, paving the roadway with brick, some form of asphalt, concrete, or some form of treated macadam, constructing the sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sewer in said avenue to the inner line of the curbs on said avenue; in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said proposed improvement prepared by the engineer of said village, which plans are hereby approved.

(b) That the grade of said avenue as improved shall be as shown on the plans and profiles to wit:

EAST CURB - Beginning at intersection of the East curb of Drexel Avenue with the north line of Main Street at elevation 103.35 ft. Village datum; thence by a 0.29% ascending grade 640 ft. to a point at elevation 105.20 ft.; thence by an 0.4% ascending grade 700 ft. to a point at elevation 108.00 ft.; thence by a 0.54% descending grade 500 ft. to a point at elevation 105.3 ft.; thence by a 0.3% ascending grade, 575 ft. to the south line of Dale Avenue at an elevation 107.03 ft.

WEST CURB - Beginning at the intersection of the west curb of Drexel Avenue with the north line of Main Street at elevation 103.10 ft. Village datum; thence by a 0.33% ascending grade 640 ft. to a point at elevation 105.20 ft. from which point the curb is the same elevation as the East curb to the north line of Dale Avenue.

(c) That the whole cost of said improvement, less one-fiftieth thereof and the cost of intersections, shall be assessed in proportion to the special benefits which may result from the improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to wit: All lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement, and in an amount equal to the cost thereof.

(d) That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in ten annual installments, with interest on deferred payments at a rate not exceeding six per cent per annum; provided that the owner of any property assessed may, at his option, pay such assessment or any number of installments of the same at any time after such assessment has been levied, with interest to the semi-annual interest day of said bonds next following date of payment;

(e) That bonds of said village of Bexley Ohio, shall be issued in anticipation of collection of the assessments by installments, and in an amount equal thereto;

(f) That the remainder of the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid by the issuance of bonds of the village in the manner provided by law.
