RESOLUTION. No. 144

WHEREAS, It has been determined by Council to assess the whole cost, less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections, of the improvement of Drexel Avenue from Broad Street to the North line of Denver Avenue in proportion to the special benefits which may result from said improvement; and,

WHEREAS, an estimated assessment was made before the completion of said improvement and before the cost thereof had been accurately determined; and

WHEREAS, the improvement has been completed and it is now necessary to make a correct assessment of said cost and expense, NOW THEREFORE:-

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

That G. R. Wannemacher, H. T. Fishpaw and E. S. Stukey, three disinterested freeholders of said Village, be and they are hereby appointed a board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in an ordinance Number 75, passed April 22, 1915, in proportion as nearly as may be to the special benefits which may result from said improvement to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed, and to report to this council the said estimated assessment.
