Declaring It Necessary to Improve Bullitt Park Place from the North Line of Bexley Ave. to the South Line of the Improved Roadway of Broad St.

Resolved By the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, three-fourths of all members elected and appointed thereto concurring:

Section I: That it is necessary to improve Bullitt Park Place from the north line of Bexley Ave. to the south line of the improved roadway of Broad St. in said village by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with brick, concrete, some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, and constructing water & sewer connections from the water main and sanitary sewer in said avenue to the inner line of the curb on said avenue, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates, and profiles of said proposed improvement, prepared by the engineer of said village, which plans are hereby approved.

Section II: That the grade of said avenue as improved shall be as shown upon the plans and profiles, to-wit:

East Curb: Beginning at a point in the proposed curb line of Bullitt Park Pl. Avenue and in the north line of Bexley Ave, said beginning point being designated as Station 0 and having an elevation of 111.00 ft. Village Datum; thence from said beginning point north with a 0.40 per cent ascending grade 792.7 ft. to a point in the south line of Broad St, at an elevation of 114.17 ft.

West Curb: Beginning at a point in the proposed curb line of Bullitt Park Pl. Ave. and in the north line of Bexley Ave, said beginning point being designated as Station 0 and having an elevation of 111.00 ft. Village Datum; thence from said beginning point north with a 0.40 per cent ascending grade 792.7 ft. to a point in the south line of Broad St, at an elevation of 114.17 ft.

Section III: That the whole cost of said improvement, less one fiftieth thereof and the cost of intersection

shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits that will result from said improvement upon the following described lots and lands to-wit: All lots and lands fronting, bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement, and in an amount equal to that portion of the cost of said improvement hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

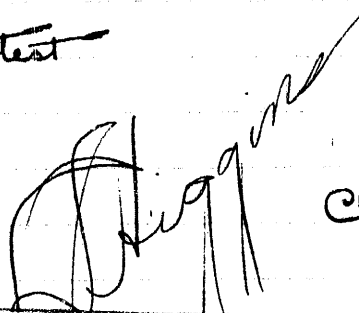
Section IV: That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in ten annual installments, with interest on deferred payments at a rate not exceeding six per cent per annum.

Section V: That bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of the assessments by installments, and in an amount equal thereto.

Section VI: That the remainder of the cost of said improvement shall be paid by the issuance of bonds of the village in the manner provided by law.

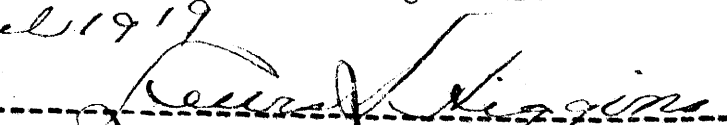
