

Ordinance 281
By the People of the Village of Besley State of Ohio.

Determining to proceed with the construction of sewers in part of District #4, as established March 15, 1921.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Besley State of Ohio:

Section 1 That it is hereby determined to proceed with the construction of a part of the sewers in sewer district #4 in said village as follows to-wit:

Commencing in Sinclair Avenue twenty (20) feet south of the south line of Charles Street, thence south in Sinclair Avenue to Livingston Avenue, thence west along the north line of Livingston Avenue to a point where said sewer will connect with the main trunk sanitary sewer in Livingston Avenue.

Section 2 That said sewers shall be constructed of vitrified sewer pipe and in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore prepared by the engineers of said village for a system of sewerage in said district, adopted by the Council on the 15th day of March, 1921, and now on file in the office of the Clerk of said village pursuant to a resolution adopted March 15, 1921.

Section 3 That the cost of said construction of said sewers less one-fiftieth thereof shall be assessed in proportion to benefits which may result from the improvement upon the following described lots and lands in said district to-wit: All lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon the proposed improvement which lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement.

Section 4 That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in five equal annual installments with interest on deferred payment, at the rate of six per cent. per annum payable semi-annually.

Section 5 That bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments levied for said improvement and in an amount equal thereto.

Section 6 That the sum of \$8965 - is hereby appropriated from the sewer funds of said village to pay the one-fiftieth of the cost of said improvement.

Section 7 That the clerk of said village be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law and that the Mayor and Clerk be and hereby are authorized and directed to execute a contract for the construction of said improvement, after advertising according to law.

Section 8 That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest point allowed by law.
