

AN ORDINANCE NO. 336.

By Mr. Ray L. Phelps.

To authorize the Trustees of Public Affairs to expend money in excess of \$500.00 for the construction of a water line in Center Avenue from first alley south of Main Street to Main Street and in Main Street from Center Avenue to Roche Avenue.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Board of Trustees of Public Affairs of said village be and hereby is authorized to expend the sum of \$1300.00 for the construction of an eight inch water line with necessary fire hydrants in Center Avenue from the first alley south of Main Street to Main Street and in Main Street from Center Avenue to Roche Avenue.

Section 2. That the sum of \$1300.00 be and hereby is appropriated from the proceeds of bonds heretofore issued for water works purposes, to pay the cost of the same.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
