Resolution No. 373. ✓

To cancel and not issue certain of a series of bonds authorized to be issued in anticipation of the levy and collection of assessments for sidewalks on Drexel Avenue.

Whereas, the council on the 28th. day of September, 1922, passed an ordinance authorizing the issue of bonds of the Village of Bexley numbered from one (1) to eight (8) both inclusive of the denomination of \$625.00 each, four bonds due October 1923 and four bonds due October 1924 aggregating in amount the sum of \$5,000 in anticipation of the levy and collection of special assessments for the construction of sidewalks on Drexel Avenue from Main Street to Dale Avenue, and

Whereas, as certain property owners constructed their own sidewalks thereby rendering it unnecessary to sell more than five of said bonds, now therefore,

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, that bonds numbers one to three, both inclusive, be canceled and not issued; that this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
