

AN ORDINANCE NO. 431.

By Mr. F. H. Bennet

To authorize the Mayor and Marshall of
the Village of Bexley to retain fees.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of
Bexley, State of Ohio:


Section 1. That the Mayor and the Marshall of the
Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, be and hereby is authorized
to retain their legal fees, in all ordinance and state
cases presented before said Mayor, and in all other actions
or proceedings within the jurisdiction of said Mayor wherein
they are entitled to charge fees. Said fees so retained are
in addition to their salaries. In the event of the marshall
retaining such fees he shall not be entitled to his expense.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be
in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




