

A RESOLUTION NO. 396.

Declaring it necessary to issue and sell bonds for the purpose of paying the village's part of the cost and expense of improving streets.

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, two thirds of all the members elected or appointed thereto concurring, that it is necessary to issue and sell bonds of said village in the sum of \$36,000.00, in the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1924, for the purpose of paying the village's share of the cost and expense of improving sundry streets, roads and avenues by grading, curbing, paving and constructing water lines therein to-wit:

Ardmore Road and Cassingham Road from Broad Street to Fair Avenue, Elm Avenue from Dawson Avenue to Cassady Avenue, Roosevelt Avenue from Main Street to Livingston Avenue, Bexley Drive from the north line of the property of the Columbus, Newark and Zanesville Electric Railway Company, to Livingston Avenue, Hartley Road and Stanwood Road from Broad Street to Fair Avenue, Remington Road from Broad Street to a point one hundred and sixty (160) feet south of Powell Avenue, Powell Avenue from Hartley Road to Gould Road, Broad Street from Remington Road to the East corporation line and Fair Avenue from Belgard to Gould Road and Main Street from the east line of Vernon Road to the east line of Roosevelt Avenue.

Be it further resolved that the question of issuing and selling the bonds of said village for the purpose and in the sum aforesaid be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of said village at a special election to be held in said village for that purpose on the 14th day of February, 1924, at the regular
