

AN ORDINANCE NO. 510.

To establish a safety zone on the north side of Main Street in
Bexley, Ohio, East of Drexel Avenue and to regulate the parking of vehicles therein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That a safety zone is hereby established on the north side
of Main Street between the East curb line of Drexel Avenue and a point 25 feet east
therefrom.

Section 2. That between the hours of 6.00 A. M. and 9.00 P. M. no
vehicle or vehicles shall stand on, or be parked on, the north side of Main Street
between the east curb line of Drexel Avenue and a point twenty-five (25) feet
easterly therefrom.

Section 3. Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of
Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor
more than twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and
after the earliest period allowed by law.
