

## An Ordinance No. 543.

Accepting deed of The Franklin Land Company for parks in Bexley Heights Addition.

WHEREAS, The Franklin Land Company has executed its deed to the Village of Bexley for all the parks shewn upon the plat of the Bexley Heights Addition as designated on the recorded plat thereof, in Plat Book No. 11, pages 15 and 16, which are located within the corporate limits of the Village of Bexley, said deed expressing a consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and the benefits that will accrue to the grantee, and

WHEREAS, it will be for the best interests of the Village to accept said conveyance, NOW, THEREFORE:


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the deed of the said The Franklin Land Company, bearing date of November 11th, 1924, conveying to the Village of Bexley, Ohio, the above mentioned parks for park and street purposes be, and the same is hereby, accepted and the Clerk is hereby directed to certify upon said deed the acceptance thereof by Council and to file same for record in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
