

AN ORDINANCE NO. 691.

Accepting deed of easement of William J. Walters and Nellie Walters for sewer and water purposes.

WHEREAS, William J. Walters and Nellie Walters, his wife, in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and the covenants therein contained, to be paid by the Village of Bexley, Ohio, have executed their deed of easement to the Village of Bexley, in and to the following described premises, to-wit:

Being a strip of ground 30 feet in width off of the north side of the following described real estate, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone in the northeast corner of said half section 18 and in the west line of Truro Township; thence S. 3-1/4° W. along the said west line 1.914 chains to a stake; thence N. 86° E. 7.92 chains to a stake in A. Vogel's east line; thence N. 4° E. with his east line 1.914 chains to an iron stake in the north line of said half section 18; thence S. 86° E. with the north line 7.90 chains to the beginning, containing one and fifty hundredths acres of land, said premises being a part of half section 18, Township No. 8, Range No. 22, Refugee Lands, being the same premises which were conveyed to said William J. Walters by Martin Walters by deed of record in D. S. 552, page 318, said County,

for the purpose of constructing and maintaining storm and sanitary sewers and water mains therein, including the right to clean, repair and care for the same and to make necessary house connections therewith, and

WHEREAS, it will be for the best interest of the Village to accept said conveyance, NOW, THEREFORE:


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the deed of easement of said William J. Walters and Nellie Walters, his wife, bearing date of March 6th, 1926, conveying to the Village of Bexley, an easement in and through the above described premises for sewer and water purposes be, and the same is hereby accepted, and the clerk is hereby directed to certify upon said deed the acceptance thereof by Council and to file same for record in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. The proper officers of the village are hereby empowered and instructed to issue the vouchers of the village to said William J. Walters and Nellie Walters in the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) out of Joint County Water Mains Fund for the payment of the consideration of said easement, which amount is hereby appropriated for said purpose.


Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
