

AN ORDINANCE NO. 735.

Granting permission to Helen R. Putnam to tap water main in Cassady Avenue at Maryland Avenue.


WHEREAS, Helen R. Putnam, the owner of part of Lots Numbers Thirty-nine (39) and Forty (40) of Anton Ruhl's Subdivision located at the north west corner of Maryland Avenue in Cassady Avenue in the Village of Bexley, has petitioned for permission to tap the water line in Cassady Avenue at Maryland Avenue for the purpose of supplying water to the above premises and has signed in writing a waiver on behalf of herself, her heirs and assigns, agreeing with the Village that when a water main shall be constructed past said premises the above described premises may be assessed for its proper proportion of the cost of said water main, and therein waiving the right to claim exemption from such assessment on the ground that said premises may already have said water service, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said Helen R. Putnam in consideration of said waiver and said agreement is hereby granted permission to tap into said water main in Cassady Avenue at Maryland Avenue for water service of the dwelling house now being constructed upon the above described premises and to lay at her own expense and under the supervision of the Street Commissioner, the necessary water line to connect said premises with said tap.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
