

## RESOLUTION NO. 653.

Providing for re-arranging, subdividing and establishing election precincts within the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

WHEREAS, at the last preceding November election more than four hundred votes were cast in certain precincts in the Village of Bexley, and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of Council it is deemed necessary and the convenience of the electors and prompt and correct conduct of elections require that the election precincts in said Village be re-arranged, subdivided and established, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That election precincts be re-arranged, subdivided and established, dividing said Village into ~~eleven~~<sup>Ten</sup> precincts to be known as Precincts A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, in accordance with and having the boundaries indicated upon the attached plat of said Village, which plat is hereby made a part of this resolution.

Section 2. Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution and plat be certified to the Board of Deputy State Supervisors of Franklin County, Ohio, for its proceedings according to law.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
