

ORDINANCE NO. 864.

Determining to proceed with the improvement of Boston Avenue from Columbia Avenue to Drexel Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the improvement of Boston Avenue from Columbia Avenue to Drexel Avenue in the Village of Bexley, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with Amiesite or Scioto Rock, and constructing sewers or drains necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and erecting street signs, in accordance with Resolution No. 643, declaring it necessary to improve said street, adopted May 24th, 1927, and in accordance with the plans, specifications and profiles heretofore approved and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting from said improvement shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the improvement, and the solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.


Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement shall be specially assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement, upon all the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement and in an amount equal to that part of the cost thereof hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the special assessments so to be levied shall be paid in accordance with the agreement of the owners of said lots and lands so to be assessed, as set forth in their petition for this improvement, that is to say, that prior to the letting of the contract by the Village for said improvement, they shall pay the estimated cost thereof into the Village Treasury in proportion to their respective abuttings upon said street, said funds to be placed in a special fund to be known as "Boston Avenue Improvement Fund" and to be used to pay the cost and expense of said improvement and in the event that said estimated costs shall not prove sufficient to complete said improvement that they will pay said additional amount found to be necessary when called upon so to do and said special assessment, in case same shall be made, shall be payable in one installment.

Section 5. That the Clerk be, and hereby is, authorized and directed, upon the payment of the cost of said improvement as hereinabove in Section 4 provided, to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.


Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
