

RESOLUTION NO. 706.

Granting permission to The Columbus Gas & Fuel Company to lay gas lines in streets and alleys in the Village of Bexley.

WHEREAS, The Columbus Gas & Fuel Company has filed its application with the Council for permission to lay gas lines in Dale Avenue from a point between Parkview Avenue and Columbia Avenue east to Dawson Avenue; thence north on Dawson Avenue to the easement between Seneca Park Place and Elm Avenue; thence east in said easement to Cassady Avenue; thence east in Elm Avenue to the first alley east of Ardmore Road; also a tie-in line on the north east corner of Parkview Avenue and Bryden Road in accordance with the plans submitted by said The Columbus Gas & Fuel Company with its application, and

WHEREAS, Council is of the opinion that said application should be granted, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That permission is hereby given to The Columbus Gas & Fuel Company to construct pipe lines in Dale Avenue from a point between Parkview Avenue and Columbia Avenue east to Dawson Avenue; thence north on Dawson Avenue to the easement between Seneca Park Place and Elm Avenue; thence east in said easement to Cassady Avenue; thence east in Elm Avenue to the first alley east of Ardmore Road; also a tie-in line on the north east corner of Parkview Avenue and Bryden Road in accordance with the plans submitted by said The Columbus Gas & Fuel Company with its application.

Section 2. Said lines shall be constructed in such locations in said streets as shall be designated by the Village Engineers, and in crossing Parkview Avenue, Columbia Avenue, Drexel Avenue, Dawson Avenue, Cassady Avenue and Ardmore Road, the same shall be done by pushing or tunneling so that the surface of said streets shall not be excavated. In case tunneling shall be

used the tunnel shall be back-filled with a mixture of sand and gravel, and said work shall be done to the approval of the street commissioner and the Village engineers.

Section 3. In the event that said lines, or any part thereof, shall later be found to interfere with street improvement or other improvements hereafter to be made, the same shall, at such points of interference, be re-located by said company as directed by the Village engineers.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
