

Resolution No. 721.

Providing for payment to Charles Yapp for damages to one table pad by officer in line of duty.

WHEREAS, one of the police officers of the Village, while in pursuit of a fugitive, shot at said fugitive and the bullet damaged and destroyed a table belonging to Charles Yapp at 633 Cassingham Road, said damage amounting to the sum of Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) and,

WHEREAS, Council is of the opinion that said officer at the time of firing said shot was in the discharge of his official duties and that said claim constitutes a proper claim against the Village and that the Village should pay the amount of said damage to the owner of said table pad,


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the claim of Charles Yapp for damage to one table pad in the sum of Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) be paid by the Village and that there be, and is hereby appropriated the sum of Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) from Contingent in the General Fund for the payment of said claim.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


