

## AN ORDINANCE NO. 1011.

To authorize the payment of the claim of Blanche Allen.

WHEREAS, on the night of the 3rd day of October, 1928, Mrs. Blanche Allen, wife of James A. Allen, of Columbus, Ohio, received certain injuries by reason of a collision of the automobile in which she was then riding with an unlighted traffic zone standard belonging to the Village of Bexley, and located in Main Street near Drexel Avenue, which said automobile was at that time being driven by her said husband, and

WHEREAS, the said Blanche Allen, through no negligence of her own, by reason of said accident has suffered damages and incurred expenses in the reasonable sum of Four Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars (\$425.00), NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the claim of Blanche Allen in the sum of Four Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars (\$425.00) for damages sustained by her on or about the 3rd day of October, 1928, as hereinabove set forth, be and the same is hereby recognized as a moral obligation of the Village of Bexley.

Section 2. That for the purpose of paying said claim there be and hereby is appropriated from the Contingent Fund in the General Fund the sum of Four Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars (\$425.00).

Section 3. That the proper officials be and hereby are authorized and directed to issue the voucher of the Village in payment of said claim upon the receipt of the release properly executed by the said Blanche Allen and her said husband, James A. Allen, of all damages arising out of said accident.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
