

## RESOLUTION NO. 833.

Declaring it necessary to construct a main drain or sewer in the north side of Broad Street from Alum Creek to a point 600 feet easterly therefrom.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That it is necessary to construct a main drain or sewer in the north side of Broad Street from Alum Creek to a point in said street 600 feet easterly therefrom for the purpose of furnishing surface and storm drainage.

Section 2. That said sewer or drain shall be constructed in accordance with the plans, profiles and specifications prepared by the Village engineer and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk, which said plans, profiles and specifications are hereby approved, and said sewer or drain shall be of concrete pipe or segment block.

Section 3. That the entire cost of said improvement and damages awarded any owner of adjoining lands and interest thereon, and the costs and expenses of any such award, shall be paid by the issuance of bonds in the manner provided by law; and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of the preliminary and other surveys and of printing and publishing the notices, resolutions and ordinances required, and the serving of said notices, the cost of construction, and all other necessary expenditures.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
