

RESOLUTION NO. 839.

Declaring it necessary to improve Bexley Park Road from Remington Road to Gould Road.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:
Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve Bexley Park Road from Remington Road to Gould Road, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with brick, asphalt, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement, constructing the necessary sewers or drains to furnish proper drainage for said improvement, constructing water lines and making the necessary service connections, constructing sidewalks on both sides of said street, and erecting street signs, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of the proposed improvement, heretofore prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Clerk, and which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the grade of said Bexley Park Road as improved shall be the grade shown by and upon the plans and profiles aforesaid, and the grade of the curbs shall be as follows, to-wit:-

NORTH CURB:

Beginning at Station 0+00 the East line of Remington Road at Elevation 111.81 and running thence with a 0.56% descending grade to Station 5+85 at Elevation 108.53; thence with a 0.36% descending grade to Station 14+018 (the West line of Gould Road) at Elevation 105.6.

SOUTH CURB:

The Elevations of the South Curb shall be the same as for the North Curb.

The above Elevations refer to Village Datum.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less one fiftieth (1/50) thereof, and the cost of intersections shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit:- All of the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement, in the amount equal to that part of the cost of said improvement hereby determined to be assessed thereon.
