Appointing Board to report estimated assessments to pay the cost and expense of certain improvements in the City of Bexley.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Council to assess a portion of the cost of the various improvements hereinafter set forth in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvements, NOW;

THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Edward C. Mills, John J. Althoen and Michael Yaekle, three disinterested free holders of said City, be and they are hereby appointed a Board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith, as set forth in the respective ordinances, as follows, to-wit:-

(a) The construction of a main storm sewer along the easterly corporation line of the City of Bexley, to be known as the Gould Road Storm Sewer, in accordance with an agreement with the City of Columbus providing for the joint construction and management thereof, as provided in Ordinance No. 1093.

(b) The improvement of Elm Avenue from Remington Road to Stanwood Road, as provided in Ordinance No. 44-31.


(c) The improvement of the first alley south of Main Street from Euclaire Avenue to Montrose Avenue, as provided in Ordinance No. 45-31,

in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvement to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and to report to this council the said estimated assessments.


Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
