

ORDINANCE NO. 33-32

Amending Section 4 of Ordinance No. 25-32, providing for the issuance of notes of the City of Bexley, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds for the improvement of Broad Street from the East end of the bridge over Alum Creek to the East corporation line, as amended by Ordinance No. 26-32, passed May 9th, 1932.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 25-32, providing for the issuance of notes of the City of Bexley, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds for the purpose of paying the municipality's portion of the cost, and in anticipation of the levy of special assessments and in anticipation of the issuance of bonds in anticipation of the collection of special assessments, for the improvement of Broad Street, (being State Highway No. 47) from the east end of the bridge over Alum Creek to the east corporation line, and being that portion of said street lying within the corporate limits of said City, which improvement is being made in cooperation with the Director of Highways of the State of Ohio, as amended by Ordinance No. 26-32, passed May 9th, 1932, be amended to read as follows:

Section 4. That such anticipatory notes in the amount of \$109,000.00, which sum does not exceed the amount of the bond issue, shall be issued bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum, payable semi-annually. Such notes shall be dated approximately the first day of June, 1932, and shall mature two years after date thereof. Such notes shall be executed and delivered in such number and such denom-

inations as may be requested by the
purchaser of such notes.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be
in force from and after the earliest period allowed by
law.
