

ORDINANCE NO. 41-33.

By Mr. Pretzman.

To establish the grade of curbs and sidewalks on Dale Avenue from the east line of Cassady Avenue to the west line of Cassingham Road in the City of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the permanent grade of the north curb of Dale Avenue from the east line of Cassady Avenue to the west line of Cassingham Road shall be and the same is hereby established, and sidewalks and future improvements shall be constructed with reference thereto, to-wit:

NORTH CURB:

Beginning at station 0+00 on the east line of Cassady Avenue at elevation 108.1; thence, on a 1% ascending grade to station 1+60 at elevation 109.7; thence, on a 0.5% descending grade to station 3+20, the west property line of Ardmore Road at elevation 108.90; thence, to the east property line of Ardmore Road to station 3+80 at elevation 108.90; thence, on a 1.5% ascending grade to station 5+40 at elevation 111.3; thence, on a 1% descending grade to the west line of Cassingham Road to station 7+00 at elevation 109.70.

SOUTH CURB:

The grade and elevation of the south curb shall be the same as that of the north curb.

The sidewalk area shall have a slope of 3/8" per foot toward the curb with a 1" drop at curb height.

The above elevations shall be held to refer to City Datum.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
