

ORDINANCE NO. 7-34


Authorizing the employment of special counsel to assist in, and to certify as to legality of, proceedings in the issuance of notes and bonds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That, whereas, it will greatly facilitate the sale and delivery of notes and bonds of the municipality hereafter to be issued for public improvements to have the proceedings therefor supervised and the legality thereof certified to by the firm of Squire, Sanders and Dempsey, Counselors-at-law, of Cleveland, Ohio, the solicitor is hereby authorized and empowered to employ as special counsel for said purpose, from time to time in connection with such issue of notes and bonds, said firm of Squire, Sanders and Dempsey to assist him in the proceedings for such issues of notes and bonds, and to render their certificate as to the legality of such issues. The sum of \$115.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to provide for such employment.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


