

## ORDINANCE NO. 17-34.

By Mr. Altmaier.

Providing for the repair of Main Street between  
Parkview Avenue and Cassady Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO: Three-fourths of all members elected there-  
to concurring:

Section 1. That the brick pavement on Main Street  
between Parkview Avenue and Cassady Road be repaired by laying  
new brick and repairing foundation where needed, in accordance  
with the plans and specifications therefor heretofore prepared  
by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Mayor,  
Department of Public Safety.

Section 2. That the entire cost of said repairs  
be paid by the City of Bexley from the Maintenance and Repair of  
Streets, Motor Vehicle License Fund.

Section 3. That the sum of \$4,200.00 is hereby  
appropriated from said Maintenance and Repair of Streets, Motor  
Vehicle License Fund for the purpose of paying the cost of said  
repairs.

Section 4. That the clerk be and he is hereby  
authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the making of  
said improvement and repairs according to law.

Section 5. This ordinance is an emergency  
ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
peace and safety, such emergency being that places in said street  
so in need of repair will render said street unsafe for public  
traffic unless said repairs are promptly made, and said ordinance  
shall go into immediate effect.
