

## ORDINANCE NO. 4-35.

Settling claim of J. S. Wilkins for sewer expense.

Whereas, J. S. Wilkins, of 850 College Avenue, Bexley, Ohio, has presented a claim to Council in the sum of \$49.00 for expenses incurred in cleaning the sewer on College Avenue servicing the premises at the above address, said work being made necessary by the fact that the roots from a tree on College Avenue in front of said premises had stopped the sewer where the same enters the main sewer under the street, and it was not ascertained until said work was practically finished that the fault was in the main sewer and that the work should have been done, or the expense thereof borne, by the City, and

Whereas, upon investigation Council is of the opinion that there is a probable liability therefor on the part of the municipality and that said claim should be settled, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the claim of said J. S. Wilkins for recovery of expenses incurred in cleaning said sewer as hereinabove set forth, as follows: John C. Huber, \$2.50; Colonial Building Materials Company, \$4.25; Ed Holmes, \$42.25; Total - \$49.00, be allowed and paid to the said J. S. Wilkins, and said sum of \$49.00 is hereby appropriated for said purpose from the Service Fund.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
