

ORDINANCE NO. 8-35.

TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE HIRING OF TRUCKS.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE
OF OHIO:

Section 1. That whereas, in the various projects under the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works certain streets and avenues are being improved in the City of Bexley requiring the hauling of materials by the city for use in said projects, the Mayor is hereby authorized and empowered to employ such trucks, with drivers, as may be necessary to haul such materials and at such prices as he may be able to obtain, not, however, to exceed \$1.00 per hour for one truck and driver, and for the payment of the cost thereof the sum of \$200.00 is hereby appropriated from the Streets Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Fund.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
