

## ORDINANCE NO. 17-35.

Authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract for the purchase of one Toro Parkway, 1935 model, Sickle Bar Mower.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Whereas, the City is in need of a weed mowing machine for the mowing of weeds along the streets, and whereas, a proposal has been received by the Superintendent of Parks for the purchase, upon approval, of one Toro Parkway, 1935 model, Sickle Bar Mower, 56-inch cut, with 2 horsepower motor; Goodyear pneumatic tired wheels, size 4.00x18; complete with two knives, at a price of \$295.00 F. O. B., less 3% if paid within twenty days, which proposal also contains the agreement that said mower should be shipped subject to satisfactory performance and subject to being returned if the same should not meet the requirements of the City, and whereas, Council is of the opinion that the Mayor be authorized to purchase such machine if, after thorough trial thereof, the same should prove satisfactory, the Mayor is hereby authorized to order said mower to be shipped in accordance with the terms of said proposal and if, after thorough trial thereof, the same should be satisfactory to said Mayor that he enter into a contract for the purchase thereof.

Section 2. That the sum of \$315.00 be and is hereby appropriated from the Streets Maintenance & Repair Gasoline Fund for the payment thereof.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the weeds are about to mature and unless promptly cut will spread disease and will re-weed, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
