

ORDINANCE NO. 12-36.

By Mr. Stackhouse.

Providing for contract for purchase of gasoline for balance of year 1936.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids, and said Mayor and Auditor are authorized to enter into contracts for the purchase of gasoline for the use of the trucks and automobiles belonging to the municipality during the balance of the calendar year 1936 in the approximate amount of 10,000 gallons, said gasoline to conform to the specifications set forth and adopted in Ordinance No. 11-36. Award of the entire amount may be made to one bidder and contract entered into therefor, or awards may be made for portions thereof with different bidders and separate contracts entered into for the amounts so awarded. Delivery to be on order of Mayor in tank on City property.

Section 2. That the sum of \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the purpose of paying the cost of said gasoline.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said gasoline is necessary for the present operation of various city departments, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
