

ORDINANCE NO. 20-36.

Authorizing purchase of automobile coupe for the Department of Water, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one Standard automobile coupe, with standard equipment and one spare tire, for the use of the Department of Water, the same not to exceed \$625.00 in price, and to exchange thereon a Model A Ford Business Coupe, 1928 Model, Engine No. A 155522.

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement had according to law. The sum of \$625.00 is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said automobile is necessary for the immediate operation of the Department of Water, and said ordinance shall go into force and effect upon the adoption thereof.
