

## ORDINANCE NO. 26-37

Authorizing the purchase of one used concrete mixer for the repair and maintenance of streets in the City of Bexley.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one used concrete mixer for use in the repair, maintenance and up-keep of streets in the City of Bexley, the same to cost not to exceed the sum of \$400.00.

Section 2. The sum of \$400.00 is hereby appropriated from the Streets Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Tax Fund for the purchase of said concrete mixer.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
