

## ORDINANCE NO. 50-38

Providing for the construction of an 8 inch water main in Livingston Avenue connecting with the existing main at Euclaire Avenue and extending eastwardly to Chelsea Avenue, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is necessary to construct, and there shall be constructed, an 8 inch water main in the north side of Livingston Avenue connecting with the existing main in Livingston Avenue and extending to Chelsea Avenue and connecting with existing mains in intersecting streets, said line being necessary for proper supply of water to the abutting properties for domestic use and sanitary purposes and to improve the circulation of water in said water system and constructing necessary water taps, in accordance with the plans, profiles, estimates and specifications therefor prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 2. Whereas, the Works Progress Administration of the Public Works of the United States has proposed and agreed to furnish all labor in the making of said improvement, and to make and perform said improvement on condition that the City of Bexley shall furnish the materials, equipment and supplies, and other direct costs, including engineering services, in accordance with the Works Progress Administration Form No. 301, now on file with the Mayor, said improvement shall be made in cooperation with said Works Progress Administration in accordance with said proposal and agreement.

Section 3. That there be and hereby is appropriated from the water fund the sum of \$5450.00 for the cost and expense of said improvement, as hereinabove provided.

Section 4. That a proper charge shall hereafter be fixed by council for water connections to be paid by the owners of

properties bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the same to be paid at the time such connections are made, and the amounts charged therefor shall be deposited to the credit of the water fund to reimburse said fund for the cost of said water taps.

Section 5. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized and directed to enter into a contract or contracts for that part of said improvement to be performed and borne by the City under said agreement, as hereinabove set forth, after advertisement according to law.

Section 6. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that properties abutting upon said improvement are in immediate need of water for sanitary and health purposes, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
