

ORDINANCE NO. 58-40

To vacate certain streets and alleys in Park Drive
Addition.

Whereas, on the 9th day of July, 1940, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of the following described streets and alleys located in Park Drive Addition, to-wit:

- (a) Park Drive from Main Street to the south terminus thereof;
- (b) The first alley south of Main Street from Park Drive to the first alley east of Park Drive;
- (c) The first alley east of Park Drive from the first alley south of Main Street to the south terminus thereof;
- (d) The second alley south of Main Street from Park Drive to the first alley east of Park Drive,

was duly presented to Council praying that said streets and alleys between the points named be vacated, which petition requested, consented and agreed that the City reserve necessary easements for the purposes hereinafter set forth; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law by posting the same in three or more public places, being the places where ordinances are posted, for six consecutive weeks ending August 27th, 1940, there being no newspaper published in the corporation, and

Whereas, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interests, and ought to be made,
NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEAUXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following described streets and alleys located in Park Drive Addition, to-wit:

- (a) Park Drive from Main Street to the south terminus thereof;
- (b) The first alley south of Main Street from Park Drive to the first alley east of Park Drive;
- (c) The first alley east of Park Drive from the first alley south of Main Street to the south terminus thereof;
- (d) The second alley south of Main Street from Park Drive to the first alley east of Park Drive,

be and the same are hereby vacated; reserving, however, to the City, the public and quasi public corporations, now or hereafter holding franchises and permits from the City for the supplying of water, gas, electricity, telephone service, all necessary easements in, under or over said streets or/alleys, for the purpose of sewers, mains, poles, wires and conduits and maintaining and keeping them in repair so far as the City may deem to be necessary to furnish its inhabitants with public utility service, sewers and drains.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
