

ORDINANCE NO. 11-41

To amend Section 68 of Ordinance No. 47-36, establishing
a traffic code for the City of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF
OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 68 of Ordinance No. 47-36
passed November 24th, 1936, be and the same is hereby amended
to read as follows:

Section 68. DUTY TO STOP IN CASE OF ACCIDENT. In
case of accident to or collision with persons or property
upon any of the public roads or highways due to the driving,
or operation thereon, of any motor vehicle, the person so
driving or operating such motor vehicle, and having knowledge
of such accident or collision, shall stop and upon request
of the person injured or any person, give such person his
name and address and in addition thereto, if not the owner,
the name and address of the owner of such motor vehicle,
together with the registered number of such motor vehicle.

Any person who violates the provisions of this section
shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction
thereof shall be fined not more than \$50.00, together with
the costs of prosecution.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be
in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
