

## ORDINANCE NO. 16-41

Authorizing purchase of automobile for the Safety Department, Division of Building and Permits, and declaring an emergency.  
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one automobile coupe with standard equipment, without heater, the cost thereof not to exceed \$800.00, and to exchange thereon one 1930 Model, Ford Coupe, being Engine Number 3665146, for use of Safety Department, Division of Building and Permits.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement has according to law. The sum of \$800.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said Safety Department is in immediate need of said automobile for the inspection of building and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
