

ORDINANCE NO. 44-41

By Mr. Harlor

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Elm Avenue from Columbia Avenue to Dawson Avenue, by grading and paving the roadway thereof with concrete base and bituminous concrete surface, constructing curbs and gutters, necessary drains, and sidewalks on each side thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Elm Avenue from Columbia Avenue to Dawson Avenue, by grading and paving the roadway thereof with concrete base and bituminous concrete surface, constructing concrete curbs and gutters and necessary drains to provide drainage for said improvement, and constructing sidewalks on each side thereof, in the aggregate amount of \$1625.00, as reported to this Council on the 5th day of May, 1941, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of the filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed, and that there be and is hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said improvement the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are now on file in the office of the Clerk of this Council, and which assessments are in proportion to the special benefits, and are not in excess of the special benefits to said property, and are not in excess of any statutory limitation, said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are as

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in five annual installments with interest at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection of the same, to-wit: 3%. All cash payments shall be made to the Auditor of said City of Bexley. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the County Auditor, as provided by law to be by him placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
