

ORDINANCE NO. 17-42 ✓

Appropriating money to defray expenses of Equipment Maintenance Mechanic.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Equipment Maintenance Mechanic be and hereby is authorized to visit the factory of Easel Signal Corporation at Moline, Illinois, for the purpose of obtaining instruction relative to the operation and maintenance of traffic control signal lights and devices, and that his expenses be borne by the municipality.

Section 2. The sum of \$75.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the above purpose.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
