

ORDINANCE NO. 19-42 ✓

Appropriating money for the operation, maintenance and upkeep of property conveyed by Robert H. Jeffrey and Mary Allen Jeffrey, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That, whereas, it is estimated that the following amounts will be necessary for the operation, maintenance and upkeep of the property conveyed to the City of Bexley by Robert H. Jeffrey and Mary Allen Jeffrey, to-wit: Salaries \$2260.00; janitor \$500.00; summer labor \$600.00; telephones \$40.00; gas \$500.00; electrical bills \$100.00; seed and fertilizer \$125.00; purchase and repair of tools \$60.00; fire, etc., insurance \$175.00; incidentals \$140.00; total \$4500.00; said sum of \$4500.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for said purposes.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
