
Appropriating moneys within the Pension Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1550.00 be, and the same is, hereby appropriated from the Pension Appropriation in the Pension Fund to the Investment Appropriation in the Pension Fund.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
