

ORDINANCE NO. 1-46

Approving bond of A. C. Kuhn, Justice of the Peace, for Bexley Township.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the bond of A. C. Kuhn, bearing date of December 7, 1945, executed in favor of the State of Ohio, for the use of Bexley Township Trustees, in the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, whereon Commercial Casualty Insurance Company is surety for the faithful performance of the duties of the office of Justice of the Peace in said township, be and the same is hereby approved. Be it further ordained that said bonds shall be deposited in the office of the City Auditor in his capacity as Treasurer, and that he notify the Clerk of The Court of Common Pleas of Franklin County, Ohio, in writing of the date of filing thereof.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
