

ORDINANCE NO. 22-48

Providing for salary of Recreation Director and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. WHEREAS, the Recreation Board has heretofore employed William Bernlohr as Recreation Director on a one-half time basis, from February 15, 1948 to June 1, 1948, and on a full time basis from June 1, 1948 to September 1, 1948, which term is about to expire, and whereas said Recreation Board has indicated its intention to extend said appointment from and after September 1, 1948 on a one-half time basis, Council does hereby fix the salary of the Director of Recreation on said one-half time basis at the rate of \$133.33 per month, from and after September 1, 1948, the same to be payable semi-monthly and to continue until further order of the Council.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the operation of the Recreation Department is dependent upon the Director, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
