

ORDINANCE NO. 7-49

By Mr. Frank

Providing penalty for resisting or abusing an officer.

Section 1. Whoever abuses a judge or justice of the peace in the execution of his office, or knowingly and willfully resists, obstructs or abuses a sheriff, constable or other officer in the execution of his office, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$50.00, together with the costs of prosecution.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
