

ORDINANCE NO. 22-49

Providing for the construction of sidewalks on the streets and avenues hereinafter described, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City has heretofore determined to construct sidewalks on certain streets, avenues and highways in the City of Bexley, and notices have been served upon property owners thereon to construct such sidewalks, and

WHEREAS, the portions of certain of said streets and avenues upon which sidewalks are to be constructed pass along public parks and grounds belonging to the City as hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Auditor have caused legal notices to be published calling for bids for the construction of sidewalks along said streets and avenues, and bids have been received thereon, and it is the sense of Council that said sidewalks should be constructed on said streets and avenues in front of said parks and public grounds, in accordance with said bids, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they are hereby authorized ^{to enter} into a contract with the lowest and best bidder under said bids heretofore received, as hereinabove described, for the construction of sidewalks upon the following described streets and avenues, to-wit:

- (a) Parkview Avenue, on the west side thereof, from Clifton Avenue to the north property line of the Jeffrey property heretofore conveyed to the City of Bexley, commonly known as the Jeffrey Park.
- (b) Parkview Avenue, east side thereof, from South Commonwealth Park to North Commonwealth Park.
- (c) Columbia Avenue, east and west sides thereof, from South Commonwealth Park to North Commonwealth Park.
- (d) Drexel Avenue, west side thereof, from South Commonwealth Park to North Commonwealth Park.
- (e) South Commonwealth Park, north side thereof, from Parkview Avenue to Drexel Avenue.
- (f) North Commonwealth Park, south side thereof, from Parkview Avenue to Drexel Avenue.

Section 2. That said improvement shall be in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles for sidewalk improvements on file in the office of the Mayor, and a performance bond in the full amount of the cost thereof be required of the contractor for the faithful performance of said contract.

Section 3. That the sum of \$6,000.00 is hereby appropriated from General Fund to pay the cost of said improvement.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the peace, health and safety of the public, said emergency being that said streets are without sidewalks, and pedestrians are required to walk in the traveled portion of said streets, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
